The KIPP Delta Region provided reading assessments and interventions to 244 students during the 2016/17 school year. A three week summer reading program was mandated for students who needed further intervention - 212 students attended intensive (small class size) programming across the region. One student was identified as dyslexic.

Universal Screening

In 2017/18, KIPP Delta will implement the new (ADE) K-2 Assessment program that mandates an online, adaptive test at least three times per year. Students who attended the summer program will be tracked during the 2017/18 school year and further evaluated using the DIBELS (Dynamic Indicators of Basic Early Literacy Skills).
