DYSLEXIA PROGRAM & NUMBERS

During the 2019/2020 School Year **all 628 kindergarten through 5th grade students** at KIPP Delta Public Schools and **26 students in 6th grade** at Blytheville College Preparatory School were evaluated several times during the school year using DIBELS 8th Edition Universal Screener. In addition, students in grades 6-12 demonstrating reading difficulties were also screened.

385 students were identified as needing reading intervention. Our interventionists served **238 students**. The other **147 students** are receiving classroom interventions during the remediation block.

51 students exhibited the characteristics of dyslexia and have been identified for further screening.
