DYSLEXIA PROGRAM & NUMBERS

During the 2020/2021 School Year **628 kindergarten through 5th grade students** at KIPP Delta Public Schools were evaluated three times during the school year using DIBELS 8th Edition Universal Screener. In addition, students in grades 6-12 demonstrating reading difficulties as identified by Lexia, SRI, and/or ACT Aspire were also screened.

504 students were identified as needing reading intervention in grades K-12. Our interventionists served **258 students**. The other **246 students** received classroom interventions during the remediation block.

99 students exhibited the characteristics of dyslexia and have been identified for further screening.
