DYSLEXIA PROGRAM & NUMBERS

During the 2021/2022 School Year **542 kindergarten through 5th grade students** at KIPP Delta Public Schools were evaluated two times during the school year using DIBELS 8th Edition Universal Screener. In addition, students in grades 6-12 demonstrating reading difficulties as identified by Lexia and/or ACT Aspire were also screened.

397 students were identified as needing reading intervention in grades K-12. Our interventionists served **38 students**. The other **359 students** received classroom interventions during the remediation block.

173 students exhibited the characteristics of dyslexia and have been identified for further screening.
